

Setting up JoVE Content with OpenOlat

Embedding JoVE Videos [Watch a video tutorial](#)

Before starting to embed videos, please **login to your JoVE account**.

If you don't have a JoVE account yet, please **sign up** at <https://www.jove.com/account>. **Make sure you select a role of "Professor / Instructor"** when creating your account. This will enable students to access the videos off-campus.

1. Generate the Embed Code
 - a. Log into your JoVE account
 - b. Navigate to the video you would like to embed
 - c. Click on "Embed", then "Copy Embed Code"
2. Add Embed Code in OpenOlat
 - a. Log into OpenOlat
 - b. Go to "Authoring"
 - c. Select the learning resource / course you would like to embed the video in and click on "Edit" at the far right side of the screen
 - d. Navigate to "Insert Course Elements" and select "Single Page"
 - e. Name the page and click "Save"
 - f. Select "Page content"
 - g. Click on "Create Page and open in Editor", then navigate to the Embed Key <> and paste the Embed Code
 - h. Click "OK", then "Save and close"
 - i. Navigate to "Demo Course" in the top navigation bar, then click "Yes, automatically"
 - j. You can then navigate back to the page you created and preview the embedded video.

Loading a Common Cartridge File with JoVE Content [Watch a video tutorial](#)

You can request a common cartridge from your customer success specialist by sending a list of the videos you would like to add to your course. Don't know who your dedicated specialist is? Just email CustomerSuccess@jove.com. Once you have the cartridge, the instructions below will walk you through the process of loading it into OpenOlat.

1. Within OpenOlat, navigate to "Authoring"
2. Click on "Import", then select a file by clicking on the icon at the far right
3. Choose a title for your learning resource, then click "Import"
4. On the new screen, click on "PREPARATION" then select "PUBLISHED" from the drop down menu
5. Select "common cartridge" in the top navigation, which will take you to the common cartridge
6. Click on "My entires", then click "Edit" at the far right, to edit the desired course
7. Navigate to "Insert Course Elements", then select "CP Learning Content"
8. Select a short title for your resource, then click "Save" at the bottom of the page
9. Next, navigate to "Learning Content", then click "Select, Create or Import CP learning content"
10. Select the common cartridge and click "Save"
11. Select "Demo Course" at the top of the screen and click "Yes, automatically"
12. You can then navigate back to the common cartridge import (on the left of the screen) and preview the various videos within your common cartridge
